
INTERIOR SURFACE PREP

Clean Dry & Dull!





- Taped and Sanded Drywall
- Remove all sanding dust
- Prime with PVA Primer
- Check surface for imperfections (small holes, dings)
- Patch imperfections
- Sand Patches
- Reprime Patches
- Paint



- Previously Painted Walls
- Flat and Eggshell Paint
- Wash any dirty, greasy areas, especially around light switches, outside corners
- Patch all holes and dents
- When dry, Sand all patches and touch ups with 1 coat of finish product
- Paint



Previously Painted Walls Satin, Semi-Gloss or Gloss Paint

- Wash walls with a solution of TSP and Warm Water using a Medium Grit foam sanding block
 - Especially areas of greater abuse and/or contamination (Bathrooms, Kitchens, Mudrooms, Hallways, etc.). This will clean, degrease and degloss.
- Rinse with water
- Patch all holes, nicks and dings with spackle
- When dry, Sand patches
- Prime walls with 1 coat of an appropriate Primer
- Paint

Wood Doors & Trim

Bare Wood

- Fill all nail holes with appropriate putty or filler
- Prime with 1 coat of an appropriate primer
- Paint with Door and Trim Paint

Previously Painted/Finished or Laminated Surfaces

- Wash all areas with a solution of TSP and Warm Water using a Medium Grit Foam sanding block
- Rinse with water
- Prime all areas with 1 coat of an appropriate Primer
- Finish with Door and trim paint or equivalent in selected finish
